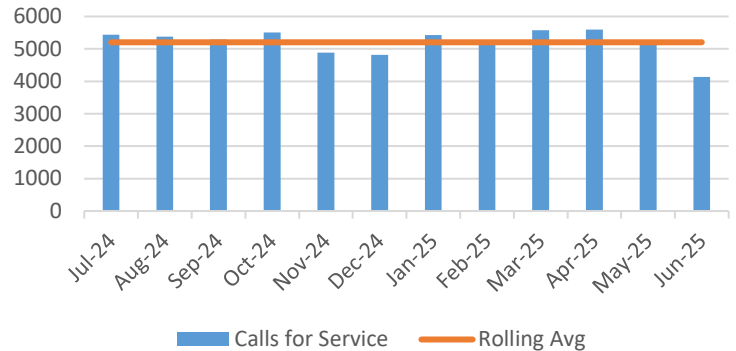
WCSO received 26 applications and progressed 7 into the background phase. There were 3 new hires.

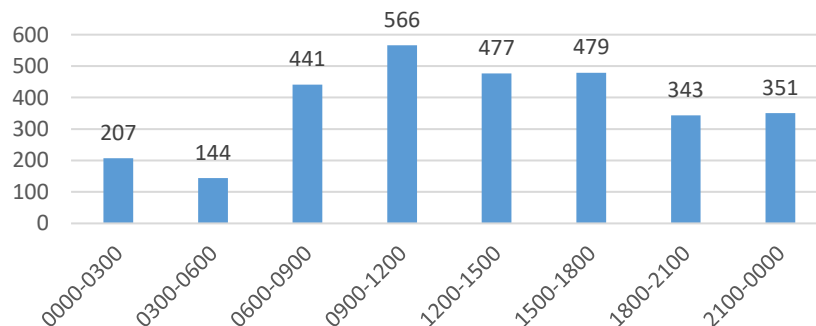

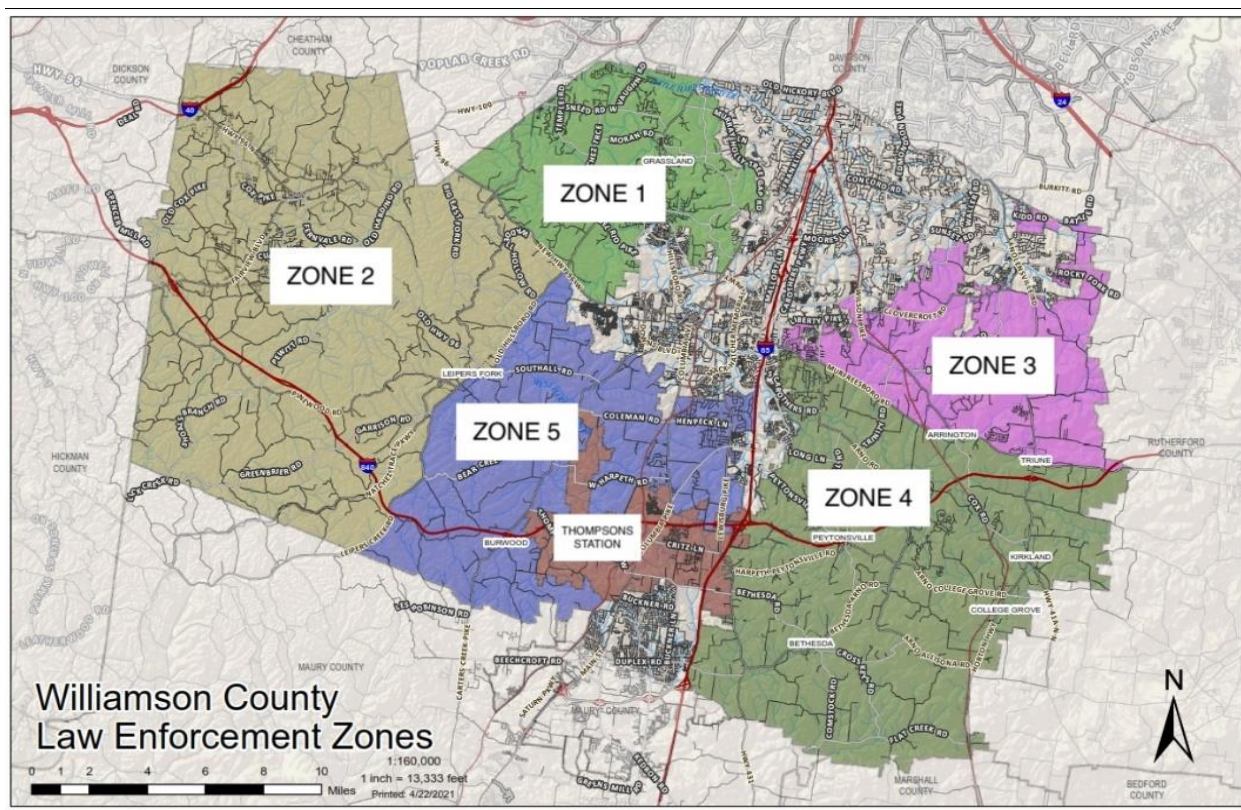
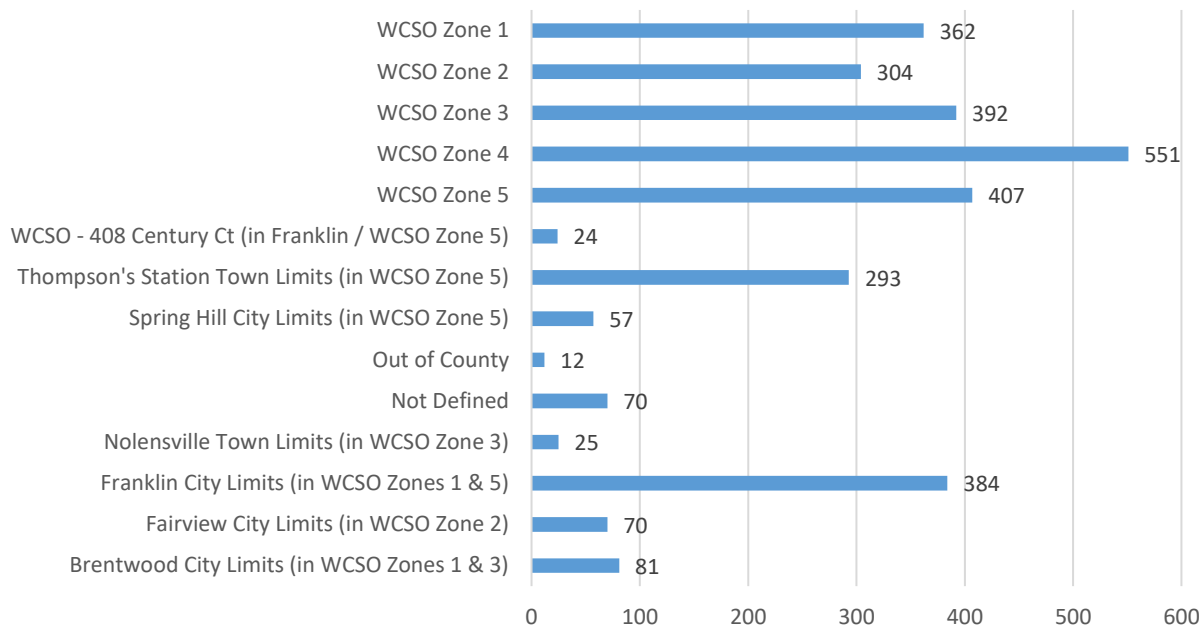
Self-Initiated Activity

June 2025



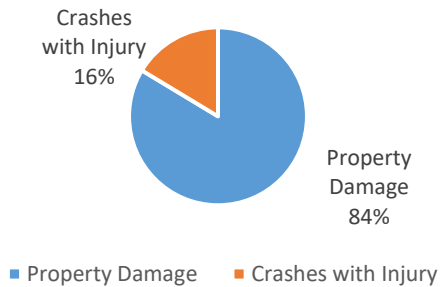
Patrol/K-9/Traffic Activity by Area June 2025



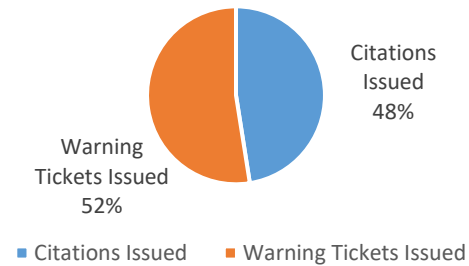

Mental Health Co-Responder

WCSO is utilizing Tennessee's Mobile Crisis Services when needed until VBHCS fills this position or an alternative solution is identified. No co-responder monthly data is available during this vacancy (October 2024 to current).

SPECIAL OPERATIONS

Aviation

Air1 flew multiple patrols, including several flights specific to Bonnaroo traffic/interdiction in coordination with WCSO Traffic Unit. There was additional cooperation with Patrol on a foot pursuit of a trailer theft suspect (subject was located by patrol) and to assist them in locating a disabled vehicle. They also assisted Warrants Division with a warrant service and CID with aerial surveillance for an investigation. In partnership with the community, Aviation flew to a Boy Scout Camp at Franklin First United Methodist Church, and to the Maury County Sheriff's Office for their Junior Academy. The Huey helicopter was also utilized at this month's Swift Water Rescue Team training.

Crime Prevention

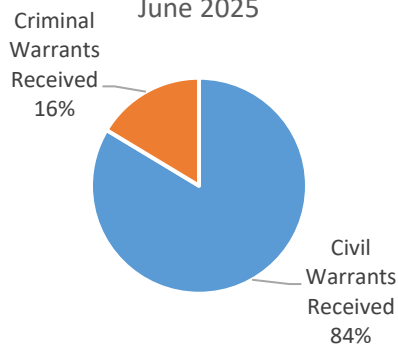

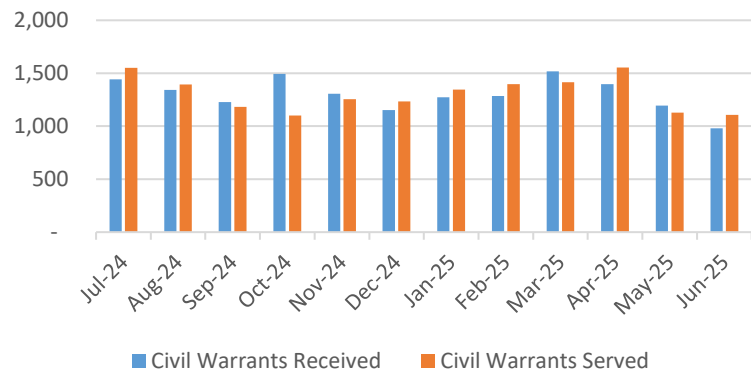

June 2025



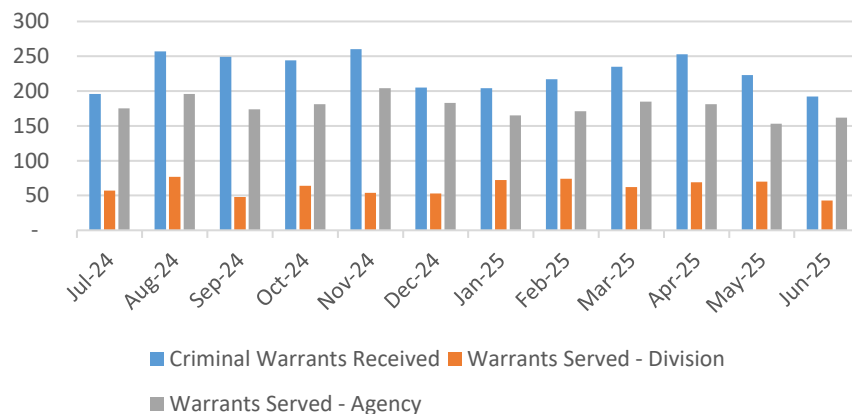
■ Civil Warrants Received ■ Criminal Warrants Received

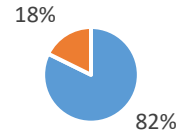

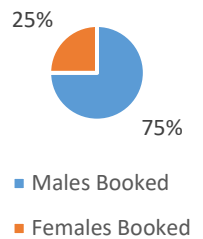

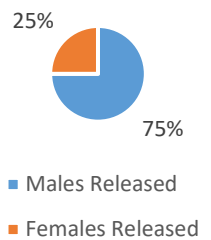
Population Averages
June 2025



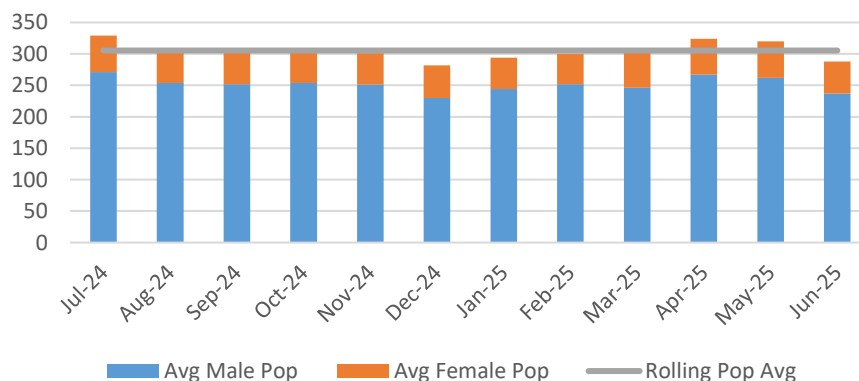
Detention Bookings
